

How many keyboard inputs are there on a Vi205?

Applies to: Vi-205

- ♦ There are two: a main input and a spot input
- ♦ The Main keyboard input will give you full control of the DVR and control the main monitor output
- ♦ The Spot keyboard input will give you control of the spot monitor output
- ♦ You can connect these keyboard inputs to a Vi-K1, Vi-K2 or Vi-K3 keyboard using a CAT5 cable
- ♦ Over a distance of 100 metres or less, the CAT5 will carry the video and power to the keyboards from the DVR, and data back from the keyboard to the DVR. A monitor may be plugged into the BNC connector on the keyboard.
- ♦ For longer cable runs (up to 1000m) it will be necessary to send the video from the corresponding BNC output (main or spot) on the DVR via coax cable to the remote monitor. It will also be necessary to power the keyboard using the mains adaptor supplied.
- ♦ Note that Vi-K2 and Vi-K3 keyboards should always be powered by the mains adaptor.
